Understanding Communicative Competence

The complexity of the notion of 'communicative competence' increased by the development of the term 'Communicative Language Ability' by Bachman in 1990 This term refers to both "knowledge, or competence, and the capacity for implementing or executing that competence in appropriate contextualised communicative language

The notion of communicative competence is broader than just verbal commu-nicative competence (nonverbal communication has been studied also very inten-sively) but my interest in this paper will focus only on verbal communicative competence and on its relation to the notion of language competence from which it originated

Communicative Competence - COSA

Chomsky's abstract notion of competence, Hymes undertook ethnographic exploration of communicative competence that included "communicative form and function in integral relation to each other"[3] The approach pioneered by Hymes is now known as the ethnography of communication

A State of the Art of Communicative Competence Theory

The notion of communicative competence was first coined by Hymes' (1972) as a reaction to Chomsky's (1965: 4) notion of competence and performance Hymes reacted to Chomsky's description of linguistic competence and linguistic performance with his description of communicative competence in 1971 (as cited in Savignon, 1991)

- Acquisition of linguistic competence is believed to be independent of sociocultural features
- Performance has a notion of sociocultural content, but is primarily concerned with psychology rather than interaction
- Structure is taken as the "primary end in itself" (1971, 272)

Achieving Communicative Competence: The Role of Higher ...

The notion of competence first began with Chomsky (1965, p 4) who defined it as 'the speaker-hearer's knowledge of his language' This knowledge of the rules of grammar is grammatical or linguistic competence To include knowledge of the rules of language use, Hymes (1972) proposes communicative competence as a broader notion of competence
